I. Approval of Minutes

- June 12th, 2025, Regular meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

II. Chairman's Report

- Talked about opening on Green Committee, encouraged anyone who might be interested to go on line and apply.
- Discussed course tour, we are transitioning to the summer Bermuda, new trees were planted on hole 16. More trees will be added maintenance Monday in between holes one and two. There were three dead trees removed from hole 12 and new trees will be replanted.
- The underground spring that was providing the water at the pond on hole two has dried up and now we have to add water.

III. Golf Course Superintendent's Report: Justin Vasquez

- Needle tined the greens on maintenance Monday and aeriated the collars.
- The fairways have been sprayed to kill the winter rye and the Bermuda is being fertilized and water to promote growth.
- Larry Mensch asked about the TWG working to reset the stacking blocks on the 18th tee. They will try a few things to stop the displacement of the blocks.

- Based on the recommendation of the Green Committee, the board decided to delay the replacement of the main water line on the course.
- The Board also decided to delay the bunker project until next year.
